Soft Hindutva: Rahul visits Gujarat temples

Cong VP's 3-day trip also includes public meetings in tribal regions

Gujarat vice-president Rahul Gandhi on Saturday began his three-day north Gujarat tour with a visit to the Akshardham temple of the Swaminarayan sect, giving clear indication that his party would continue to paddle what political observers call 'soft Hindutva'.

The visit is significant as the Swaminarayan sect has a large following among the Patel community, now belligerent to the ruling BJP over the quota issue, but its head, Pramukh Swami, last week openly asked the party to return the favour to the present government in the state.

During his earlier visits to Gujarat over the last two months, Rahul has also visited temples at Dwarka, Chotila and Santram temple in Mehsana, and the Birla mandir. Apart from temple visits, Rahul's three-day trip through north Gujarat would



ancient Ambaji temple in Banaskantha district, the Becharaji temple near Mehsana and Virat Mugh Maya temple in Patan.

After a brief 'tilak' and 'daan-shan' at the Akshardham temple, Rahul left for Chittaranjan, east of Ahmedabad, before heading back to Mumbai. Apart from temple visits, Rahul's three-day trip through north Gujarat would

Governance at virtual standstill in Himachal

Along, painful wait by both people and politicians has begun, after the culmination of a hectic poll process in November. The late of the finalising of the EVM-VVT machines will be known only on 18 December along with the people's own fate - whether the ruling Congress will retain power, or BJP will form the new government. The model code of conduct will remain in force till then and the government of Himachal Pradesh will stay somewhat paralysed. No new appointment and major decisions will be allowed to be taken until the legally permitted by the Election Commission.

Many intelligent citizens in the state are against this long wait and the problems arising from partial non-governance for such a long time. "How can the poll results of a small hill state like Himachal reflect the outcome of the entire country? The terms and issues are so different. Even elections were to be held in a neighbouring state, there may be some unsubstantiated argument in it; but in this case, bracketing the poll results of these two states on the same date and confirming the code of conduct for such



a long time in Himachal does not seem to be fair."

By such a yardstick, it is argued, in the age of electronic media, all states should follow under the Model Code of Conduct. In all the 29 states you found. The standard claims of both the Congress and BJP leaders that their own party will win with a

"shining majority" are being received with a punch of sarc and amusement. BJP leaders claim that record polling of votes (about 75%) for the 68 assembly seats in Himachal indicate "people's mood for a change in government".

Chief Minister Vilasinha Singh has predicted a convincing victory for the Congress.

But a veteran observer of politics over the last few decades says that the political mood at this stage - everything is still guess work. As always, the common voter is silent or just evasive. But BJP workers' mood is upbeat, while Congress workers seem to be cautious. Overall, it's like a slow-motion move.

Missing girl: HC warns of action against cops

Taking a strict note of the Mumbai Police's failure to find a minor girl who was reported missing from the city five years ago, the Bombay High Court said that if the police failed to do its duty, it will not hesitate in initiating a punitive action against it.

A bench of justices S.C. Dharmadhikari and Bhushan Dange recently dismissed the police's submission that it made all possible efforts to trace the girl, but it was "impossible" to find her.

The bench questioned why the police failed to make inquiries at "construction sites, domestic sewage, fishing trawlers, illegal dairies, automobile garages, etc." for those were most children who usually go missing.

"The police machinery holds its hands and says it is impossible to trace the child. They say, we have done everything that is permissible and possible at our disposal. The report filed does not indicate that all out efforts are made," the bench observed.
